INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, representatives from all municipalities in Jackson County whose police departments sponsor Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) or similar anti-drug programs have made a joint request to the COMBAT Commission and County Legislature, regarding the formula for Jackson County's funding of these programs for the 2001-2002 term; and,

WHEREAS, the consensus reached among the municipalities and COMBAT staff was that these programs be funded in the following amounts:

WHEREAS, at its meeting of August 8, 2002, the COMBAT Commission endorsed the recommendations of the municipalities and agencies involved; and,

WHEREAS, the attached form contract provides a suitable mechanism by which the requested funds can be transferred to the participating municipalities; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute contracts with the cities of City of Blue Springs, City of Grandview, City of Independence, City of Kansas City, City of Lee's Summit, City of Grain Valley, City of Oak Grove, and City of Raytown, in the aggregate amount of \$1,122,909.00, in a form substantially similar to that attached; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contracts.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
