WHEREAS, the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission has awarded the Sheriff's Office a grant in the amount of \$25,000.00 to cover the "Safe Routes to School Enforcement" program for the period of August 18, 2010, through June 6, 2012; and,

increased moving and non-moving violation enforcement, and education programs for students, neighbors, and parents regarding traffic safety for automobiles, cyclists, and pedestrians within a two (2) mile radius of Indian Creek Elementary School in Kansas City, MO; and,

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Sheriff's Department will use the grant funds for reimbursement of overtime used for "Safe Routes to School Enforcement" program; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place the grant funds in the appropriate spending accounts; now therefore,
