WHEREAS, in 1992 Colleen started volunteering for Hope House, an Independence-based shelter for battered women and children, and later served as board chair from 1994-96 and co-chair for a 1998 endowment campaign that raised more than \$1 million; and,

WHEREAS, Colleen was also this year's co-chair of Hope House's major annual fund raiser, "Hope and All that Jazz," which raised \$170,000; and,
