WHEREAS, the execution of agreements for the services of these agencies, in the amounts indicated

on Exhibit A, is in the best interest of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Jackson County;

now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive

be, and hereby is, authorized to execute agreements with the outside agencies listed on the attached

Exhibit A, in the respective amounts indicated, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor;

and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be, and hereby is,

authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreements.
