WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing has solicited formal written bids on Request for Proposals No. 85-12 for a thirty-six month contract for the furnishing of a web filtering, malware detection, prevention, and mitigation solution for use by the Information Technology Department on

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends award of a thirty-six month contract the furnishing of a web filtering, malware detection, prevention, and mitigation solution at a total cost to the County over the life of the contract not to exceed \$20,172.99, to Braxton Grant Technologies of Woodstock, MD, as the lowest and best bidder; and,
