INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 12950, dated November 22, 1999, the Legislature authorized a contract with Health Productivity Systems of Kansas City, MO, for the furnishing of urinalysis testing for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Deferred Prosecution and Drug Court programs; and,

WHEREAS, by a First Addendum to Agreement dated September 5, 2000, the terms of said contract were extended; and,

WHEREAS, the Legislature did, by Resolution 13657, dated April 9, 2001, authorize a Second Addendum to the Agreement, increasing the contract in the amount of \$160,000.00 and extending the terms of the Agreement for an additional twelve months; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 14260, dated July 15, 2002, the Legislature did authorize a Third Addendum to the Agreement, increasing the contract in the amount of \$14,500.00 and extending the
