ORDINANCE 2992, February 14, 2000

WHEREAS, Section 3.3 of the Series 1996 and 1997 Leasehold Revenue Bond Lease Agreements between Jackson County and the Jackson County Public Building Corporation require the Jackson County Legislature to annually adopt an Ordinance setting forth:

- 1) the renewal of each Lease for an additional one-year term; and,
