AN ORDINANCE amending the districts established by the Jackson County Zoning Order by changing from A (Agricultural) to RR (Residential Ranchette), a certain 60 ± acre tract, and approving the preliminary plat "Oak Ridge Timbers" creating a ten-lot residential subdivision.

ORDINANCE # 3214, December 3, 2001

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:
Section 1. The Zoning Order of Jackson County, Missouri, and the official maps which are a part thereof, are amended by changing the boundaries of the "A" (Agricultural) District and the "RR" (Residential Ranchette) District so that there will be transferred from District A to District RR a tract of land as follows:

Description: A 60 ± acre tract of land generally located at the northwest corner of Missouri Highway F and Parrent Road and specifically described as a tract of land being all of the south 60 acres of the
