## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**AN ORDINANCE** approving a conditional use permit to operate a child day-care center as to a certain 5 <u>+</u> acre tract.

ORDINANCE 3089, November 6, 2000

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. A conditional use permit for five years to operate a child day-care center, under the Unified Development Code, is hereby approved as to a certain tract of land described as follows: DESCRIPTION:

<u>Section 2</u>. The conditional use permit granted by this ordinance is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the applicant comply with all State and County regulations relative to a Child Day Care Center being operated under the Conditional Use Permit. Upon renewal of State and County Permits, the applicant shall provide copies to the Public Works Development Division.
- 2. That the Child Day Care Center shall be limited to an occupancy level of 30 people because of the on-site wastewater (septic) system.
- 3. That the on-site area designated for wastewater disposal be isolated to the extent that it will not be accessible to children.
- 4. That all driveways and parking areas located on subject tract be surfaced and paved.
- 5. The outdoor play area of the child day care center shall be enclosed with a fence, which shall be built and maintained to a minimum height of four (4) feet.
- 6. The Child Day Care Center shall be operated only between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Legislature, pursuant to the application of Brendan Teevan, (CU-00-048), requesting approval embodied in this ordinance and with notice that the Jackson County Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of this application in a public hearing on October 19, 2000, does adopt this ordinance pursuant to the Jackson County Charter authorizing the Legislature to exercise legislative power pertaining to planning and zoning.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its signature by the County Executive.
