ORDINANCE # 2851, September 8, 1998										
INTRODUCED BY Victor E. Callahan, County Legislator										
WHEREAS, Missouri Constitution, article X, section 6 and section 139.600, RSMo 1994, provide for a tax levy to be charged against the assessed valuation of real property listed in subclass 3 (utility, industrial, commercial and railroad property) of class one property (real estate), to replace revenues lost from the exemption of merchants' and manufacturers' inventories; and,										
WHEREAS, this replacement levy has been calculated in accordance with section 139.600, RSMo 1994; therefore,										
BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the 1998 replacement levy is \$1.437 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real property in subclass 3 of class one propertyAttorney Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its signature by the County Executive.
