## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE amending the districts established by the Jackson County Zoning Order by changing from A (Agricultural) to RE (Residential Estates), a certain 6.5 ± acre tract.

## **ORDINANCE 3072**, October 9, 2000

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Zoning Order of Jackson County, Missouri, and the official maps which are a part thereof, are amended by changing the boundaries of the "A" (Agricultural) District and the "RE" (Residential Estates) District so that there will be transferred from District A to District RE a tract of land described as follows:

Description:

A 6.5 ± acre tract of land generally located ½ mile north of Easley Road on the west side of Alley-

Jackson Road and more specifically described as:
A tract of land located in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 47 North of the Base Line, Range 30 West of the 5 <sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian all in Jackson County, Missouri more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the NW corner of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 Section 9, T47N R30W; thence N 89°59'42" E along the north line of said quarter quarter a distance of 1329.73 feet to the NE corner of said quarter quarter; thence S 01°35'02"W along the East line of said quarter quarter a distance of 302.58 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence S 01°35'02" W along the said East line a distance of 360 feet to the SE corner of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of said quarter quarter; thence S 89°57'46" W along the South line of said N $\frac{1}{2}$ of said quarter quarter a distance of 785.05 feet; thence N 01°34'07" E parallel with the West line of said quarter quarter a distance of 785.14 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 6.49 acres, more or less, subject to any easements, restrictions, or covenants, recorded or unrecorded, if any.
<u>Section 2</u> . The Legislature, pursuant to the application of Thomas Cornwell (RZ-2000-203), requesting the amendment embodied in this ordinance and with notice that the Jackson County Plan Commission unanimously recommended this application in a public hearing on September 21, 2000, does adopt this ordinance pursuant to the Jackson County Charter authorizing the Legislature to exercise legislative power pertaining to planning and zoning.
Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its signature by the County Executive.
