RESOLUTION #12375, September 29, 1998

WHEREAS, Ms. Hughes also served as a Jackson County legislator from 1972 to 1978; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. Hughes' passionate crusade for the rights of others has led her to help citizens in the City's central core who struggle for decent housing, neighborhoods, and health benefits; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. Hughes has five children, three stepchildren and two grandchildren, and is married to Dr. Samuel U. Rodgers; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. Hughes will be honored at a dinner on September 24 at the Marriott-Muehlebach Tower, with a reception from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature recognizes Mamie Hughes upon having received the 1998 Woman of the Year award from the Central Exchange, and commends her for her efforts in assisting individuals with special needs in the Kansas City community.
