WHEREAS, the City of Independence has requested a 20 foot wide electric utility easement through Adair Park in order to run underground electrical services to a transformer controlling new ball field lights; and,

WHEREAS, the grant of this easement will not harm the park and is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute an easement in favor of the City of Independence, to carry out the above stated purposes in the form attached hereto...Attorney
