RESOLUTION # 11623, February 24, 1997

INTRODUCED BY John C. Graham, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department proposes to improve a section of roadway designated as Longview Road and Orchard Road to Blue Ridge; and,

WHEREAS, in order to construct and improve said roadway, it is necessary to relocate and rebuild distribution lines in order to furnish continuous electrical service to Kansas City Power and Light Company customers served by said lines, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$6,253.00; and,

WHEREAS, to effect this relocation, the Department and Kansas City Power and Light have negotiated and recommend the terms of the attached agreement; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the attached agreement is hereby approved, and that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached agreement on behalf of the County; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the Agreement...Attorney

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
