ORDINANCE #2610, December 2, 1996

INTRODUCED BY John Patrick Burnett, County Legislator

WHEREAS, Section 539.00 of the Jackson County Code requires the County Legislature to adopt a tentative tax levy sufficient to provide for appropriations in the county budget; and,

WHEREAS, the 1997 annual county budget would require the following tax levies on each hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the fiscal year 1997:

WHEREAS, pursuant to authorization granted by Sections 67.500 through .545, RSMo 1994, the qualified voters in Jackson County on November 6, 1979, approved Jackson County Proposition #1 which imposed a county-wide sales tax on one-half of one percent and required
