WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Department is in possession of certain personnel property that has become excess to the County's needs, specifically one Glock Model 22 handgun, serial no. S-DAN 001US; and,

WHEREAS, this weapon has been rendered inoperable and is otherwise unusable; and,

WHEREAS, this weapon, which was formerly assigned to Sheriff James D. Anderson, is of great sentimental value to Sheriff Anderson's family; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri that the above-referenced personal property be and hereby is declared surplus personal property and that the Purchasing
