# IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE repealing § 4248., Jackson County Code, 1984, relating to amusement licenses and enacting, in lieu thereof, one new section relating to the same subject, with an effective date.

ORDINANCE 2785, February 23, 1998

# INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

Section A. Enacting Clause. Section 4248., Jackson County Code, 1984, is hereby repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as 4248., to read as follows:

4248. Theater Licenses.

The license for theaters (including movie and motion picture shows) is as follows:

#### 4248.1 Fee

The license fee for theaters is two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), except that the fee for subrun theaters is fifty dollars (\$50).

#### 4248.2 Drive-In Theaters.

The license for all drive-in theaters where passenger vehicles are admitted to the enclosure from which the performance may be observed is one hundred fifty dollars (\$150).

#### 4248.3 Theater, Definition.

Theater is defined as a setting for the presentation of motion pictures or dramatic performances. Each stage (for dramatic performances) or motion picture screen (for movies) is a theater.

# 4248.4 Subrun Theater, Definition.

A subrun theater is a theater as defined in subsection 3 of this section, for which the price of admission at no time exceeds two dollars (\$2) per person.

Section B. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective as of July 1, 1998...Attorney

Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its signature by the County Executive.
