WHEREAS, the County did, by Resolution 9771, dated May 24, 1993, enter into a contract with Barber & Sons Aggregates of Kansas City, MO, in the amount of \$339,934.10 for the furnishing of crushed rock for use by the Public works Department; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed increase to this contract is necessary due to a higher than expected usage, and this increase will not exceed \$35,000.00; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the increase to the aforesaid contract is approved and the Director of Purchasing is authorized to execute the necessary documents on behalf of the County; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Manager of the Division of Finance is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
