AN RESOLUTION transferring \$33,334.00 within the 2014 General Fund and authorizing the County Executive to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with the City of Kansas City, Missouri, the Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners, and the Research Foundation of the City University of New York, c/o John Jay College of Criminal Justice, Center for Crime Prevention and Control, for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Office's No Violence Alliance Project, at an actual cost to the County not to exceed \$33,334.00.

RESOLUTION NO. 18693, December 15, 2014

INTRODUCED BY Crystal Williams, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18036, dated November 27, 2012, the Legislature authorized an agreement for the Prosecuting Attorney's Office's No Violence Alliance Project (NoVA), a collaborative initiative between key law enforcement leaders in Kansas City to reduce violent crime in Kansas City's urban core through a mix of law enforcement and social service components; and,

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney, in collaboration with the Kansas City Police Department and the City of Kansas City, Missouri, desire to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Center for Crime Prevention and Control, a research foundation located at John Jay College of Criminal Justice in New York, NY; and,

WHEREAS, the Center for Crime Prevention and Control will work with the County, the City of Kansas City, and the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department to further their efforts at reducing violent crime in the Kansas City area; and,

WHEREAS, this Agreement will run through December 31, 2015, at a total cost in the amount of \$100,000.00, with each of the three entities providing one-third of the cost, or \$33,334.00; and,

WHEREAS, a transfer is necessary to place the funds necessary for the County's portion of this Agreement in the appropriate spending account; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends this transfer; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following transfer within the 2014 General Fund be and hereby is made:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Legislature of Jackson County that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with the Center for Crime Prevention and Control, the City of Kansas City, MO, and the Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners, in a form substantially similar to that attached, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$33,334.00; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract.
