IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE amending the zoning districts established pursuant to the Unified Development Code by rezoning a certain 3.00± acre tract from District AG (Agricultural) to District RE (Residential Estates).

ORDINANCE NO. 5612, April 11, 2022

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Zoning Order of Jackson County, Missouri, and the official maps which are a part

thereof, are amended by changing the boundaries of the "AG" (Agricultural) and "RE" (Residential

Estates) Districts, so that there will be transferred from District AG to District RE a tract of land, in

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Jackson County, MO, legally described as follows:

requesting the amendment embodied in this Ordinance and with notice that the Jackson County Plan

Commission voted 7 to 0 to recommend <u>APPROVAL</u> of this application after a public hearing on

March 17, 2022, does hereby adopt this Ordinance pursuant to the Jackson County Charter

authorizing the Legislature to exercise legislative power pertaining to planning and zoning.
