WHEREAS, certain employees within the Public Works Department in the position of public health specialist have petitioned the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 53 (IBEW) to represent them; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive is willing to recognize the IBEW as the exclusive bargaining representative in order to discuss salaries, benefits, and general working conditions for all employees in the covered positions; and,

WHEREAS, one of the first steps in the process of reaching agreement on a Memorandum of Understanding between the County and the IBEW is to have the IBEW recognized as the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees; and,

WHEREAS, the attached Recognition Agreement is a suitable mechanism by which to permit the County and the IBEW to engage in negotiations concerning working conditions of its members; now therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the attached Recognition Agreement recognizing the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 53; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the parties are to provide the Legislature with any negotiated agreement for its review and for whatever action the Legislature deems appropriate...Enacted and Approved

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
