AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$1,300.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2021 Anti-Crime Sales Tax Fund in acceptance of funds received from members of the Jackson County Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force.

ORDINANCE NO. 5522, June 21, 2021

INTRODUCED BY Theresa Cass Galvin, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Task Force (JCDF) is a multi-jurisdictional task force formed to counter the illegal drug problem in Jackson County; and,

WHEREAS, cities located in Jackson County, as well as the Missouri State Highway Patrol and the Jackson County Sheriff, make up the representative agencies of the task force; and,

WHEREAS, annually the JCDF receives a Justice Assistant (JAG) Grant from the U.S. Department

of Justice that is administered through the Missouri Department of Public Safety; and,

WHEREAS, the current JAG grant application includes a requirement that the member agencies of the JCDF contribute at least a nominal annual payment to further the goals and operations of the task force; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors for the JCDF has requested each member contribute one hundred dollars; and,

WHEREAS, the JCDF has received \$1,300.00 from its member agencies and the Executive Board of the JCDF has directed that this year's funds be used for maintenance and repairs to JCDF-owned automobiles; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place these funds in the proper spending account; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation be made from the undesignated fund balance of the 2021 Anti-Crime Sales Tax Fund:
