WHEREAS, pursuant to section 2836., <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, the City of Blue Springs, MO, has requested the use of its County Urban Road System (CURS) funds in the amount of \$156,119.83 to cover the cost of improvements to Woods Chapel Road; and,

WHEREAS, this project is a part of the CURS system; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends approval of the request; and,

WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that the Woods Chapel Road improvements by the City will benefit the citizens of Blue Springs and the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that, pursuant to chapter 28, <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, the Director of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to issue a check in the amount of \$156,119.83 as a lump-sum payment to the City of Blue Springs for use by the City on improvements to Woods Chapel Road.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
