AN ORDINANCE approving a conditional use permit to operate a kennel as to a certain 6 <u>+</u> acre tract.

ORDINANCE 3090, November 6, 2000

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. A conditional use permit for ten years to operate a kennel, under the Unified Development Code, is hereby approved as to a certain tract of land described as follows:

Borgman Road.
<u>Secti</u>	on 2. The conditional use permit granted by this ordinance is subject to the following conditions:
1.	That the number of dogs kept on the property is limited to ten (10).
2.	That the kennel shall be private and limited to only the property owner's dogs and shall not be operated as a boarding/commercial animal establishment.
3.	That all dogs must be contained in the residence or the fenced area unless under the control of and obedient to the command of a responsible person.
