A RESOLUTION authorizing the County's deferred compensation providers to offer Roth 457 plan options to County employees, at no cost to the County.

RESOLUTION NO. 18838, June 1, 2015

INTRODUCED BY Scott Burnett, County Legislator

WHEREAS, a Roth 457 plan is a type of defined contribution retirement plan in which taxes are paid on the contributions but not on the withdrawals; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends under section 810, Jackson County Code, 1984, that the County's deferred compensation providers be authorized to offer a Roth 457 plan option to County employees as an employee benefit, at no cost to the County; and,

WHEREAS, offering this additional employee benefit is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County's employee benefits plans include an option for Roth 457 defined contribution retirement plan; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to execute any documents necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
