A RESOLUTION awarding a term-and-supply contract on Bid No. 79-95 for the furnishing of inmate clothing for use by the Department of Corrections to Robinsons Textiles of Gardenia, CA, ATD American of Philadelphia, PA, Bob Barker of Fuquay, NC, Hamilton Uniforms of Crosswicks, NJ, Carefree Uniforms of Carefree, AZ, and Skirvin & Clayton of Kansas City, MO to provide for departmental needs for the upcoming one-year period, in the estimated aggregate amount of \$141,063.07.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has solicited formal written bids on Bid No.79-95 for the furnishing of inmate clothing for use by the Department of Corrections; and,

WHEREAS, following evaluation of the bids submitted, the Purchasing Director recommends that the contract be divided and awarded to the vendors submitting the lowest bid for each item; and,

WHEREAS, award as recommended would result in awards to the following vendors:
