### IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**A RESOLUTION** authorizing the County Executive to execute temporary construction and permanent water main easements in favor of the City of Grain Valley, in connection with the construction of the new Public Works Maintenance Facility.

WHEREAS, the County is building a new maintenance facility along Old 40 Highway; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 13828, the County did authorize an agreement with the City of Grain Valley, for the installation of a 12" waterline to serve the new facility; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Grain Valley has requested a temporary construction and permanent water main easement across County property located at the new maintenance facility; and,

WHEREAS, the easements requested, copies of which are attached hereto, are in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached temporary construction and permanent water main easements in favor of the City of Grain Valley.
