IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION reappointing Melissa Patterson-Hazley to the Central City Economic Development Sales Tax District Board, for a new term to expire November 14, 2023.

RESOLUTION NO. 20288, October 14, 2019

INTRODUCED BY Ronald E. Finley, County Legislator

WHEREAS, at the election held April 4, 2017, the voters of Kansas City, Missouri, approved the Central City Economic Development Sales Tax, Question 4, a retail sales tax of one-eighth (1/8) of one cent for the support of development and revitalization along the Prospect Avenue corridor; and,

WHEREAS, approval of the question submitted authorized the creation of the Central City Economic Development Sales Tax District Board and the imposition of the sales tax; and,

WHEREAS, section 67.1305, RSMo., the enabling legislation for the creation of the district, provides that the district be governed by a board whose membership is to include a member selected by a majority vote of the Legislature; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 19543 dated July 31, 2017, the Legislature did appoint Melissa Patterson-Hazley to this board; and,

WHEREAS, it is now appropriate that the Legislature adopt this Resolution reappointing Ms. Patterson-Hazley to a new four-year term on this board; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that Melissa Patterson-Hazley be and hereby is reappointed to the Central City Economic Development Sales Tax District Board for a four-year term, expiring on November 14, 2023, under section 67.1305, RSMo.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
