IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION increasing the term-and-supply contract on Bid No. 4-95 for the furnishing of urinalysis testing for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Deferred Prosecution and Drug Court programs with Health Productivity Systems of Kansas City, MO, in the estimated amount of \$54,000.00.

RESOLUTION #12006, January 12, 1998

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 10762, dated April 3, 1995, a term-and-supply contract with Health Productivity Systems of Kansas City, MO, for the furnishing of urinalysis testing for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Deferred Prosecution and Drug Court programs was approved; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 11363, dated July 22, 1996, an increase to this contract in the amount of \$100,000.00 was approved; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 11762, dated May 19, 1997, another increase to this contract in the amount of \$100,000 was approved and its term was extended through April 30, 1998; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to further increase this contract in the amount of \$54,000.00 in order to allow Health Productivity Systems to continue providing urinalysis services to participants of the Deferred Prosecution and Drug Court programs through the end of the contract term; and,

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has recommended the increase to this contract upon the terms and conditions of the Third Addendum attached hereto; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the increase to the term-and-supply contract be made as recommended by the Purchasing Director, and that the Purchasing Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the increase; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract, to the extent sufficient appropriations to the using spending agency have heretofore been made in the current Jackson County budget. Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
