A RESOLUTION expressing the Legislature's support for the development of a bicycle trail between Buckner and Sibley parks.

RESOLUTION #15652, October 3, 2005

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, Dan Tarwater, Scott Burnett, Eugene Standifer Jr., Fred Arbanas, Bob Spence, Rhonda L. Shoemaker, Robert A. Stringfield, and Henry C. Rizzo, County Legislators

WHEREAS, the City of Buckner is contemplating the development of a bicycle trail along the east side of Buckner-Tarsney Road from the stoplight intersection of Highway 24 in the City of Buckner and thence northward to historic Fort Osage in Sibley, Missouri; and,

WHEREAS, the upcoming development of the Fort Osage Education Center will attract more visitors to the area and increase the need for a more extensively developed bicycle trail to accommodate the growing needs of the community; and,

WHEREAS, in addition, development of the trail will provide safer access to Heisler Park and nearby swimming pool facilities; and,

WHEREAS, providing trail ingress for the additional tourists will also increase the potential number of consumers and boost commercial development and business interests in the area; and,

another opportunity for recreational activity; and,
WHEREAS, there may be an opportunity for funding of the bicycle trail through the Mid-America
Regional Council (MARC) for which the President of the Buckner Chamber of Commerce has
requested community support; now therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County
Legislature expresses its support for the development of a bicycle trail between Buckner and Sibley.
