WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has solicited bids under Electronic Bid No. BB200248 for the furnishing of crushed rock for use by the Public Works and Parks and Recreation Departments to provide for departmental needs for the upcoming one-year period; and,

WHEREAS, out of seventeen invitations to bid, the only bid received was from Barber & Sons Aggregates of Lee's Summit, MO; and,

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has recommended that award be made to Barber & Sons Aggregates of Kansas City, MO, for the reason that it has submitted the best bid; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as recommended by the Purchasing Director, and that the Purchasing Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract, to the extent sufficient appropriations to the using spending agencies have heretofore been made in the current Jackson County budget.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
