## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**AN ORDINANCE** granting a conditional use permit (CUP) in District A (Agricultural) for a period of twenty-five (25) years to continue operating a 299-ft. microwave communications tower as to a  $1.3 \pm$  acre tract.

**ORDINANCE # 3474,** March 8, 2004

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. A conditional use permit is hereby granted for a period of twenty-five (25) years to continue operating a 299-ft. microwave communications tower as to a  $1.3 \pm acre tract$  described as follows:

Description: The 1.3  $\pm$  acres is approximately ½ mile east of Johnson Road on the north side of Twiehaus Road and on the east side of existing substation No. 1,and specifically described as:

Part of the east half of Section 1, Township 50, Range 30 in Jackson County, Missouri aka 34900 E. Twiehaus Road.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Legislature, pursuant to the application of Aquila, Inc. (CU-2004-176), requesting approval embodied in this ordinance and with notice that the Jackson County Plan Commission unanimously recommended approval of this application in a public hearing on February 19, 2004, does adopt this ordinance pursuant to the Jackson County Charter authorizing the Legislature to exercise legislative power pertaining to planning and zoning.
