IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION transferring \$85,502.00 within the 2000 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund and authorizing the County Executive to execute contracts with certain municipalities within Jackson County for the purpose of funding their 1999-2000 Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) or similar anti-drug programs, at a total cost to the County not to exceed \$1,144,180.80.

WHEREAS, representatives from all municipalities in Jackson County whose police departments sponsor Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) or similar anti-drug programs have made a joint request to the COMBAT Commission and County Legislature, regarding the formula for Jackson County's funding of these programs for the 1999-2000 term; and,

WHEREAS, the consensus reached among the municipalities and COMBAT staff was that these programs be funded in the following amounts:
