## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION authorizing the County Executive to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Fort Osage School District for its Drug Prevention/Truancy Neglect Program, to provide a local match to a state grant, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$78,570.00.

WHEREAS, the Fort Osage R-1 School District's "Truancy Prevention" program is designed to improve academic achievement by targeting students in grades K-9 that have mild to severe truancy problems, allowing for early intervention into school attendance problems, and providing an avenue for holding parents responsible for getting their children to school; and,

WHEREAS, the District has received a grant from the Missouri Local Investment Commission for the program in the amount of \$258,018; and,

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office recommends the execution of a Cooperative Agreement with the Fort Osage School District, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$78,570.00, which sum may serve as a portion of the required local matching funds for this program; now therefore,
