## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**A RESOLUTION** awarding a six-month contract with one twelve-month option to extend on Request for Proposals 17-16 for the furnishing of an Employment Barriers Program for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Office to Twelfth Street Heritage Development Corporation of Kansas City, Missouri, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$76,000.00.

**INTRODUCED BY** Dan Tarwater III, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office recommends the implementation of a new

Employment Barriers Program to provide re-entry assistance and support to at-risk ex-offenders

transitioning from prison back into the community; and,

WHEREAS, by Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 17-16, the Director of Finance and Purchasing did

solicit the submission of proposals from firms interested in providing these services; and,

WHEREAS, the Director distributed thirty-four notifications and received two responses to the RFP, as follows:

WHEREAS, the proposals submitted were evaluated on the basis of responsiveness to the scope of services, qualifications, experience, approach, and references; and,

WHEREAS, following evaluation of the proposals, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office has recommended the award of a six-month contract with one twelve-month option to extend for the furnishing of these services to Twelfth Street Heritage; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends that the award be made pursuant to section 1054.6 of the <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, to Twelfth Street Heritage Development Corporation of Kansas City, MO, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$76,000.00; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute for the County a Cooperative Agreement with Twelfth Street Heritage, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
