A RESOLUTION increasing the term-and-supply contract on Bid No. 4- 95 for the furnishing of urinalysis testing for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Deferred Prosecution and Drug Court program with Health Productivity Systems of Kansas City, MO, in the estimated amount of \$100,000.00.

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 10762, dated April 3, 1995, a term-and- supply contract was approved for the furnishing of urinalysis testing for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Deferred Prosecution and Drug Court program with Health Productivity Systems of Kansas City, MO; and,

WHEREAS, an increase to the term-and-supply contract with Health Productivity Systems of Kansas City, MO, is necessary as the original amount authorized of \$100,000.00 has been depleted and an additional estimated amount of \$100,000.00 is needed to finish out the contract period; and,

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has recommended the increase to the term-and-supply contract with Health Productivity Systems of Kansas City, MO, upon the terms and conditions of the First Addendum attached hereto; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the increase to the term-and-supply contract be made as recommended by the Purchasing Director, and that the Purchasing Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the increase; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract, to the extent sufficient appropriations to the using spending agency have heretofore been made in the current Jackson County budget. Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
