WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing has solicited formal written bids pursuant to Request for Proposals No. 43-08 for urinalysis testing for use by the Prosecuting Attorney's Office; and,

WHEREAS, he distributed a total of thirteen (13) solicitations and received six (6) responses, two of which were non-responsive; and,

WHEREAS, he has received as the lowest three bids, bids from the following:

WHEREAS, the bidders were evaluated according to the criteria detailed in the Request for

Proposals, including pricing, written narrative, and experience and expertise; and,

WHEREAS, the Director recommends award to Health Productivity Systems of Kansas City, MO,

which, while not the lowest bidder, submitted the lowest and best bid as determined by the evaluation

committee; and,

WHEREAS, this award is made on an as needed basis and does not obligate Jackson County to pay

any specific amount, with the availability of funds for specific purchases subject to annual

appropriation; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as

recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing, and that the Director be and hereby is

authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary for the accomplishment of the award;

and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is

authorized to make all payments on the contract, including final payment, to the extent that sufficient

appropriations are available in the then current Jackson County budget.
