IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION awarding a term and supply contract on Bid No. 128-97 for the furnishing of pipe and plumbing related supplies for use by various county departments to Reeves-Weideman Co. of Kansas City, MO (\$33,500.00), and Ferguson Enterprises of Kansas City, MO (\$33,500.00), to provide for their needs for the upcoming one-year period, in the estimated aggregate amount of \$67,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has solicited formal written bids on Bid No. 128-97 for the furnishing of pipe and plumbing related supplies for use by various county departments; and,

WHEREAS, following evaluation of the bids submitted, the Purchasing Director recommends that the contract be divided and awarded to the vendors submitting the lowest bid for each item; and,

WHEREAS, award as recommended would result in the estimated awards to the following vendors:

therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as recommended by the Purchasing Director, and that the Purchasing Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
