IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION transferring \$46,016.00 within the 1996 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund and authorizing the County Executive to execute contracts with certain municipalities within Jackson County for the purpose of funding their 1995-1996 Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) or similar anti-drug programs, at a total cost to the County not to exceed \$911,042.00.

WHEREAS, on April 17, 1996, representatives from all municipalities in Jackson County whose police departments sponsor Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) or similar anti-drug programs met with the staff of the Prosecuting Attorney's office for the purpose of making a recommendation to the COMBAT Commission and County Legislature, regarding Jackson County's funding of these programs for the 1995-1996 term; and,

WHEREAS, the consensus reached among the municipalities and staff at this meeting was that these programs be funded in the following

WHEREAS, at its meeting of April 26, 1996, the COMBAT Commission endorsed the recommendations of the Prosecuting Attorney's staff and municipalities and agencies involved; and,

WHEREAS, the attached form contract provides a suitable mechanism by which the requested funds can be transferred to the participating municipalities; and,

WHEREAS, a transfer within the 1996 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund is necessary to effect the recommendation with regard to the Jackson County Sheriff's Department; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends such transfer; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following transfer be and hereby is made within the 1996 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund:
