IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE amending the districts established by the Jackson County Zoning Order by changing from D (agricultural district) to RR (residential ranchette zoning district), a certain 10-acre + tract.

ORDINANCE 2475, October 23, 1995

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

Section 1. The Zoning Order of Jackson County, Missouri, and the official maps which are a part thereof, are amended by changing the boundaries of the "D" agricultural district and the "RR" residential ranchette zoning district so that there will be transferred from District D to District RR a tract of land described as follows:

A 10+ acre tract generally located 400 feet south of Bynum Road Spur and east of Bynum Road lying in that part of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 47, Range 29.

Section 2. The Legislature, pursuant to the application of Leona Pedrow (RZ-95-009), requesting the amendment embodied in this ordinance and with notice that the Jackson County Planning Commission favorably recommended this application in a public hearing on September 21, 1995, does adopt this ordinance pursuant to the Jackson County Charter authorizing the Legislature to exercise legislative power pertaining to planning and zoning.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its signature by the County Executive.
