## IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**A RESOLUTION** authorizing the County Executive to execute an Agreement to Extend the Memorandum of Understanding with Local Union No. 42 of the International Association of Fire Fighters through July 31, 2009.

WHEREAS, by Resolution 15511, dated June 6, 2005, the Legislature did authorize the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Local Union No. 42 of the International Association of Fire Fighters (the Union) to govern the terms and conditions of employment of members of its bargaining unit within the Prosecuting Attorney's Office through December 31, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, the parties have undertaken negotiations on a successor MOU, but have not yet reached agreement; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 16805, dated January 20, 2009, Resolution 16855, dated March 16, 2009, Resolution 16891, dated April 27, 2009, and Resolution 16922, dated June 1, 2009, the Legislature did authorize the extension of the existing MOU through June 30, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, negotiations have continued to progress but have not yet resulted in a successor MOU
