Title: Continuing in Jackson County, Missouri, a countywide sales tax at the rate of one-quarter of one percent for a period of seven years solely for the purpose of arrest and prosecution of those accused of drug-related offenses, the prevention of such offenses, and the incarceration, rehabilitation, treatment, and judicial processing of adult and juvenile violators of drug-related offenses, repealing sections 9301., 9303., 9305., and 9306., Jackson County Code, 1984, relating to the anti-drug sales tax, and enacting six new sections in lieu thereof, relating to the same subject.
