WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney recommends that the award be made to Health Productivity of Kansas City, MO, for the reason that it has submitted the lowest and best bid; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made to Health Productivity of Kansas City, MO, in the estimated annual amount not to exceed \$103,350.00 as recommended by the Prosecuting Attorney, and that the Purchasing Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Manager of the Division of Finance is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract, to the extent sufficient appropriations to the using spending agency have heretofore been made in the current Jackson County budget.
