BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made to Document Automation Development of Overland Park, KS, for the furnishing of a scanning system for a cost not to exceed \$0.0690 for a term of twelve (12) months as recommended by the Director of Purchasing , and that the Purchasing Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary for the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract thereby made, to the extent that sufficient appropriations to the using spending agency are contained in the then current Jackson County budget.
