IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION awarding a thirty-six month term and supply contract with two twelve-month options to extend for the furnishing of inmate pay telephone services for use by the Corrections Department to Century Link, of Overland Park, KS, under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposals No. 34-11, for a commission payable to the County.

WHEREAS, the Corrections Department has a need for providing inmate pay telephone services;
and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing has solicited formal written bids on Request for Proposals No. 34-11 for the furnishing of inmate pay telephone services; and,

WHEREAS, a total of nineteen solicitations were distributed and three responses were received and evaluated as follows:

WHEREAS, Century Link will provide these services at no cost to the County and will pay a minimum annual guarantee (MAG) on commissions to the County; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1054.6, Jackson County Code, 1984, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of the contract to Century Link, of Overland Park, KS, under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposals No. 34-11 as the best bidder meeting specifications as set out in the attached recapitulation and analysis; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the award be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing and that the Director be and hereby is authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary for the accomplishment of the award.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
