A RESOLUTION awarding a term and supply contract on Bid No. 122-98 for the furnishing of blue grass and zoysia sod for use by the Parks and Recreation Department to Reed Turf Farm of Bucyrus, KS (\$5,000.00), and Greenhaven Sod of Riverside, MO (\$10,000.00), to provide for departmental needs for the upcoming one-year period, in the estimated aggregate amount of \$15,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Director has solicited formal written bids on Bid No. 122-98 for the furnishing of blue grass and zoysia sod for use by the Parks and Recreation Department; and,

WHEREAS, following evaluation of the bids submitted, the Purchasing Director recommends the contract be divided and awarded to the vendors submitting the lowest bid for each item; and,

WHEREAS, award as recommended would result in estimated awards to the following vendors:

VENDOR	AWARD
Reed Turf Farm Bucyrus, KS	\$5,000.00
Greenhaven Sod Riverside, MO	\$10,000.00

therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as recommended by the Purchasing Director, and that the Purchasing Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract, to the extent that sufficient appropriation to the using spending agency has heretofore been made in the current Jackson County budget...Attorney
