WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing has solicited bids on Electronic Solicitation No. BB200658 for the furnishing of office furniture for use by various county departments to provide for departmental needs for the upcoming twenty-four month period with annual options to extend for terms not to exceed an additional total of twenty-four months; and,

WHEREAS, a total of twenty-nine notifications were distributed and three responses were received and evaluated from the following:

WHEREAS, following evaluation of the bids submitted, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends that the contract be awarded to Corporate Express of Kansas City, MO, for the reason that it has submitted the lowest and best bid; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing, and that the Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary to the accomplishment of the award and any extensions; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract, to the extent that sufficient appropriations to the using spending agencies have been made in the then current Jackson County budget.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
