IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

A RESOLUTION authorizing the County Executive to execute an Agreement with Arts Tech of Kansas City, Missouri, for the furnishing of support services for the Teens in Transition Program, at an actual cost to the County of \$15,900.00.

RESOLUTION NO. 18843, June 1, 2015

INTRODUCED BY Alfred Jordan, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 4728, dated April 27, 2015, the Legislature did authorize an appropriation in the amount of \$60,000.00 for funds received from the City of Kansas City, Missouri, for the Prosecuting Attorney's Office's Teens in Transition program; and,

WHEREAS, the Teens is Transition program is part of the No Violence Alliance (NoVA) Project, a collaborative initiative between key law enforcement leaders in Kansas City, the regional administrator of probation and parole, and the U.S. Attorney's Office, to reduce violent crime in Kansas City's urban core through a mix of law enforcement and social service components; and,

WHEREAS, juveniles in the Teens in Transition program will participate in a ten-week summer program for approximately ten to fifteen hours per week, to provide a safe, stable, and healthy environment where the juveniles will gain the appropriate life skills training to reduce the risk of committing a violent act; and,

WHEREAS, the County is serving as the fiscal agent for this project which will run during the period
of June 2, 2015, through August 7, 2015; and,
WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney recommends a Cooperative Agreement with Arts Tech of
Kansas City (Jackson County), Missouri to provide support services and meeting space for the Teens
in Transition Program, at a cost to the County of \$15,900.00; now therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive
be and hereby is authorized to execute a Cooperative Agreement with Arts Tech, for the Teens in
Transition Program, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is
authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreement.
