### IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

**A RESOLUTION** recognizing the heroic actions of Paul Contreras at the Kansas City Chiefs' Championship Parade and Rally on February 14, 2024.

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon this body to honor and celebrate individuals like Paul Contreras,

whose valorous deeds exemplify the highest ideals of heroism and civic duty; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri that the Legislature hereby recognizes and commends Paul Contreras for his outstanding bravery, selflessness, and heroism in the face of adversity, and extends its deepest gratitude for his service to our community.
