A RESOLUTION recognizing Kelsey Bass upon her selection to the 2009 Missouri Scholars 100 program.

WHEREAS, Kelsey has a GPA of 4.47 on a 4.0 scale and is ranked 4th out of 340 students in her class; and,

WHEREAS, throughout high school Kelsey has been involved in theater as an actor and props crew

WHEREAS, Kelsey will be traveling with the theater department to London, England, during the

summer, with the opportunity to meet actor lan McKellen; and,

WHEREAS, Kelsey will attend the Missouri University of Science and Technology in Rolla, MO, in the

fall, and plans on majoring in chemistry and minoring in physics and possibly Spanish, with the goal

of earning a Ph.D. and becoming a research chemist; and,

WHEREAS, Kelsey's parents, Paul and Debbie, and her four older siblings join in Kelsey's

celebration of this distinguished award; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature
